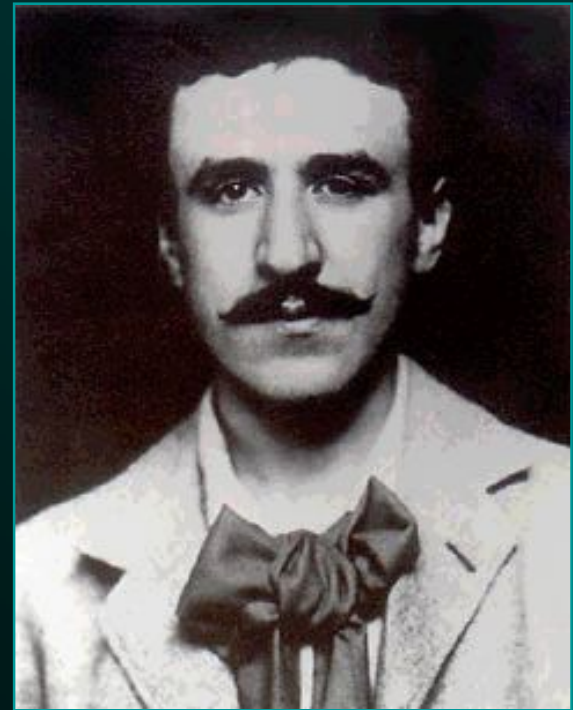

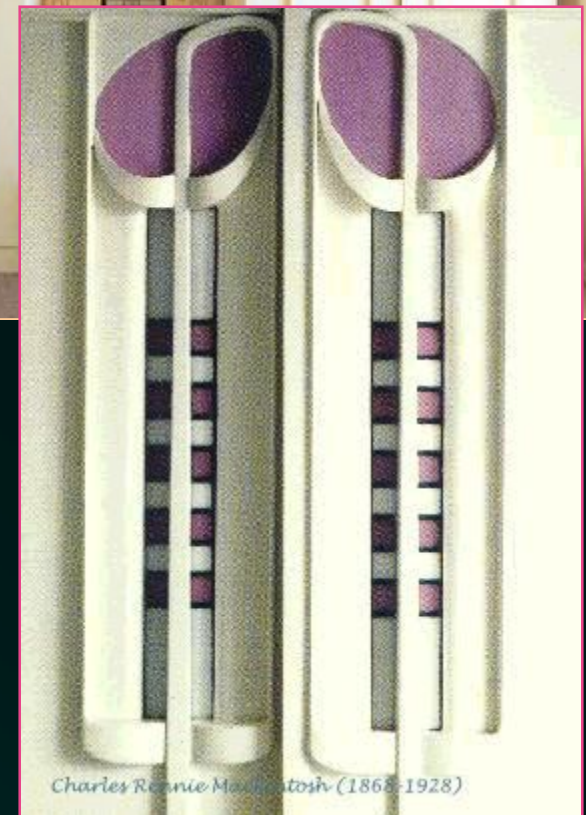

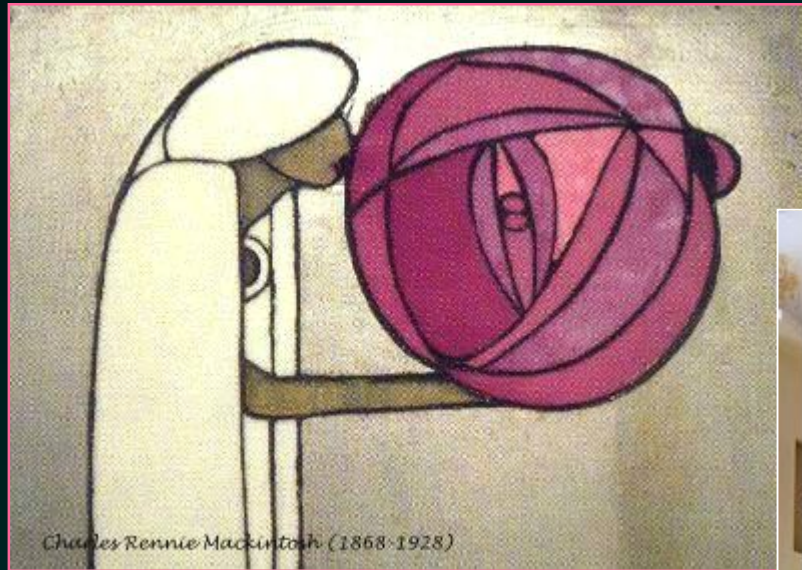

Hill House

Mackintosh collaborated with his wife Margaret Macdonald for the interior of Hill House. They designed fireplaces, furnishings, hardware and built-in wardrobes.

The walls in the house were generally white, some with delicate stencil of geometric rose designs in pink and silver.

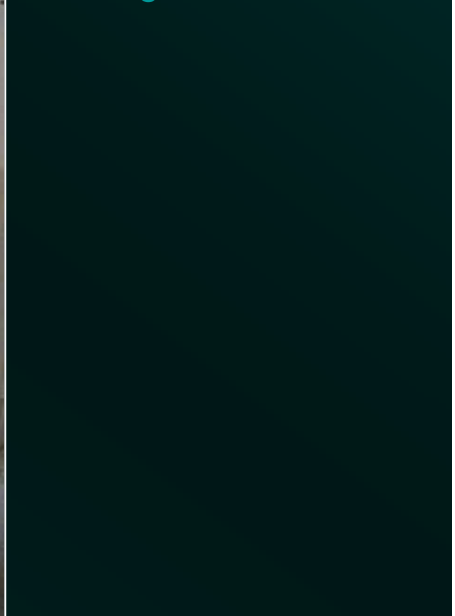

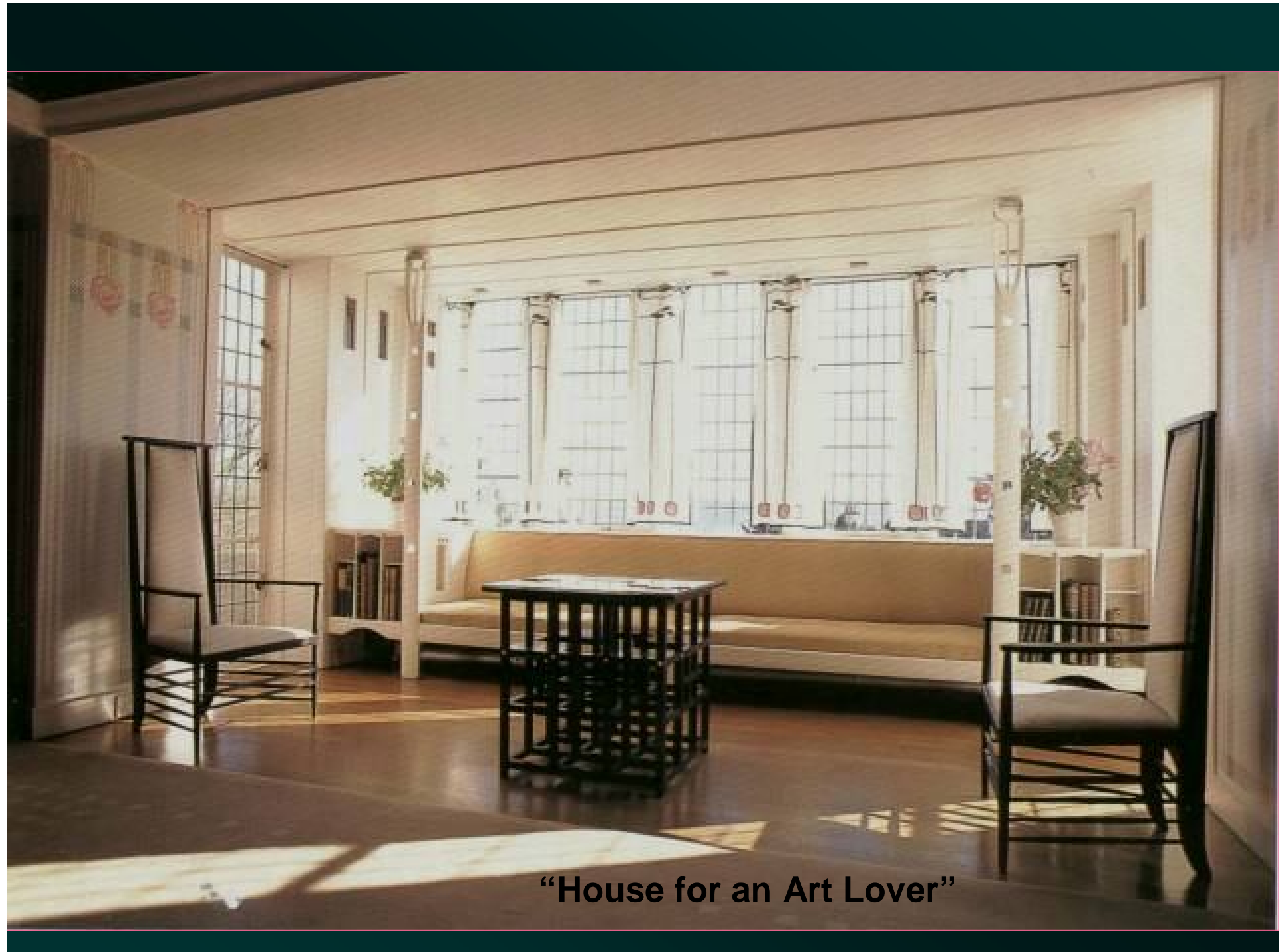
Built in Bellahouston Park almost 100 years after Mackintosh died by Glasgow City Council and the Glasgow School of Art.

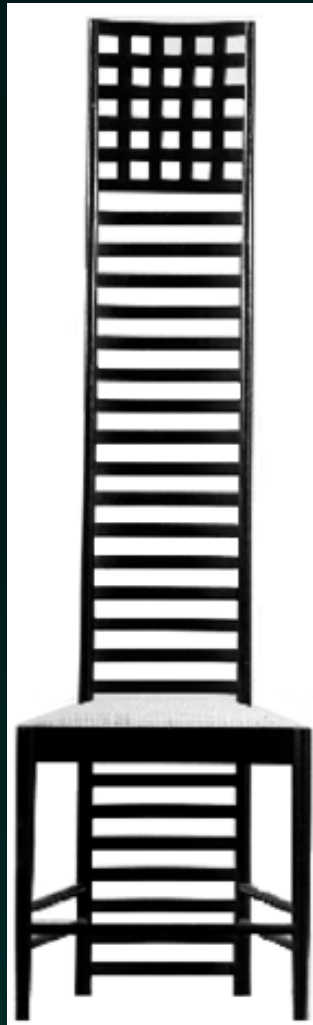
